Born in the hills of Appalachia and shaped by the quiet honesty of West Virginia life, Malachi Stone is a singer/songwriter who approaches music the way some people approach a diary. He writes to understand the world around him—to study its edges, its patterns, its contradictions, and its beauty. His songs are rooted in curiosity, grounded in lived experience, and carried by a voice shaped as much by the landscapes he’s traveled as the ones he calls home.

His songwriting always begins the same way: with something he noticed, something he felt, or something he couldn’t shake until he put it into words. His evolving style mirrors the natural rhythm of being human—changing as he changes, adapting as he grows, and never afraid to follow a new direction if it reveals something true. A well-traveled observer by nature, Malachi draws from the people he meets, the places he wanders, and the quiet moments that often go unnoticed. He writes with an eye for detail and a respect for subtlety—capturing small truths, fleeting impressions, and the emotions that sit just beneath the surface of everyday life. For him, songwriting isn’t about preaching or presenting answers. It’s about exploration.
